### **Get the Led Out To Rock Audiences in the Xanadu at Trump Taj Mahal, Saturday, April 25**

**Atlantic City, NJ – February 11, 2009;** **Get The Led Out** (Tribute to Led Zeppelin) dubbed by the press as the “*American Led Zeppelin*” will be performing in the **Xanadu at Trump Taj Mahal on Saturday, April 25, 2009**. Show time is 8:00 pm and doors will open one hour prior.

Sinclair, a BMI-affiliated songwriter, is also an engineer/producer who, along with Hammond, owns Fat City Studios just outside of Philadelphia, PA. Paul's engineering, production and mastering credits can be found on countless independent and national releases worldwide.
