The Wailers perform the legendary album *EXODUS* at Xanadu Theatre, Trump Taj Mahal, March 14

ATLANTIC CITY, NJ, January 22, 2009; The Wailers, the world's most legendary reggae group, will perform music from their classic 1977 album *Exodus* in the **Xanadu at Trump Taj Mahal on Saturday, March 14, 2009**. Show time at 8:00 pm and doors will open one hour prior.

The Wailers have sold over 250 million records worldwide. Since Bob Marley's passing in May 1981, his group has continued to carry his message of "One Love" to millions of fans worldwide. To date, they've played alongside Bruce Springsteen, Sting, the Fugees, Stevie Wonder, Carlos Santana, and Alpha Blondy and fellow reggae legend Burning Spear.

Year after year, The Wailers continue to play hundreds of dates around the globe, lead by Aston "Familyman" Barrett, bass player and musical director for the Wailers. Barrett, formerly Bob Marley's right hand man prior to the singer's death, is the sole musician who has remained in the Wailers since their inception, and is acknowledged as the single individual capable of leading the group. The lineup also features lead singer Elan Atias, discovered by former Wailers guitarist Al Anderson, who lends the songs new, youthful energy and interpretation. Driven by their undying message of peace, love and unity, the Wailers have been awarded the United Nation's Peace Medal of the Third World as well as the Jamaican Order of Merit in the course of their career.

The Wailers, currently riding high after their appearance with Kenney Chesney in his song and video "Everyone Wants to go to Heaven," will be performing their 1977 album *Exodus*, named "Album of the Century" by TIME Magazine in 1999, in its entirety, featuring such songs as "Jammin,'" "Exodus" and "One Love," named song of the Millennium by the BBC. Their live sets are known to include such classics as: "Buffalo Soldier," "Lively up Yourself," "I Shot the Sheriff," "Trench Town Rock," "Get Up Stand Up," "Roots Rock Reggae," "War," "Redemption Song," "Stir it Up," and "No Woman No Cry,".
